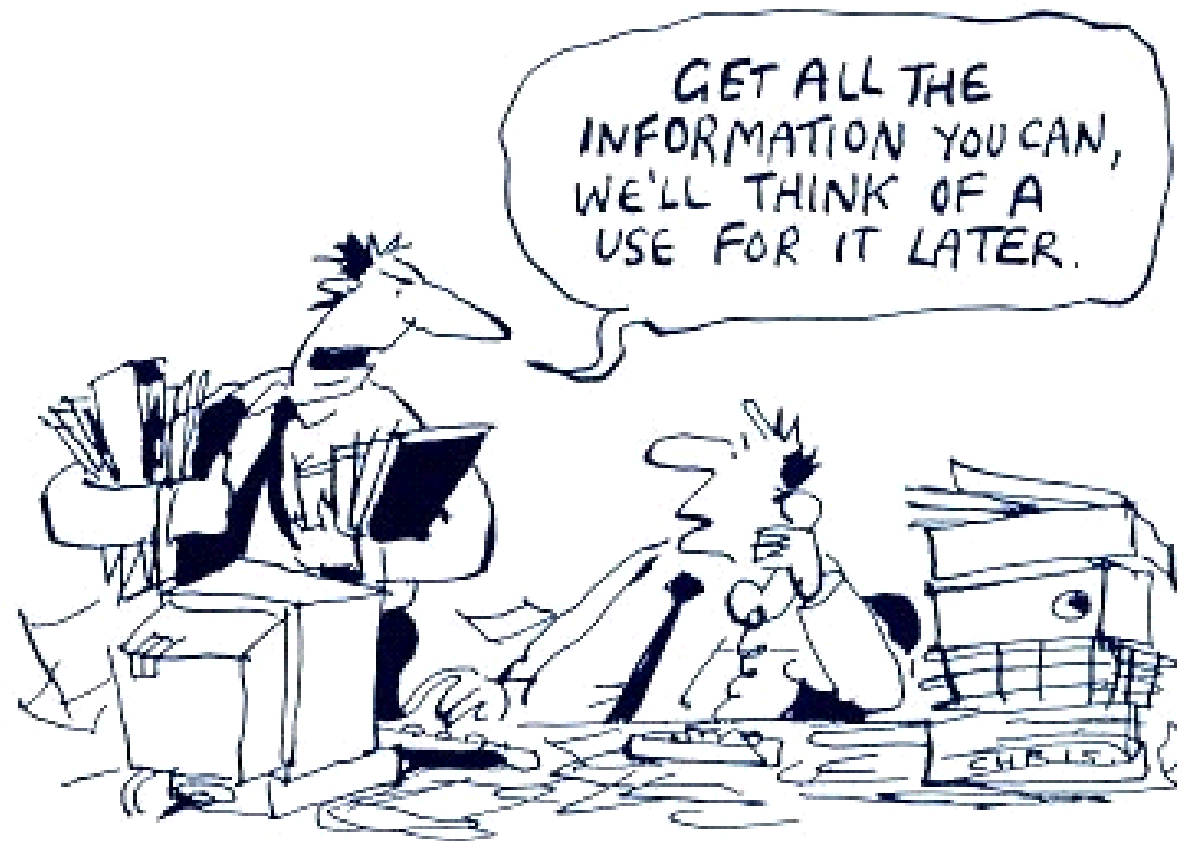

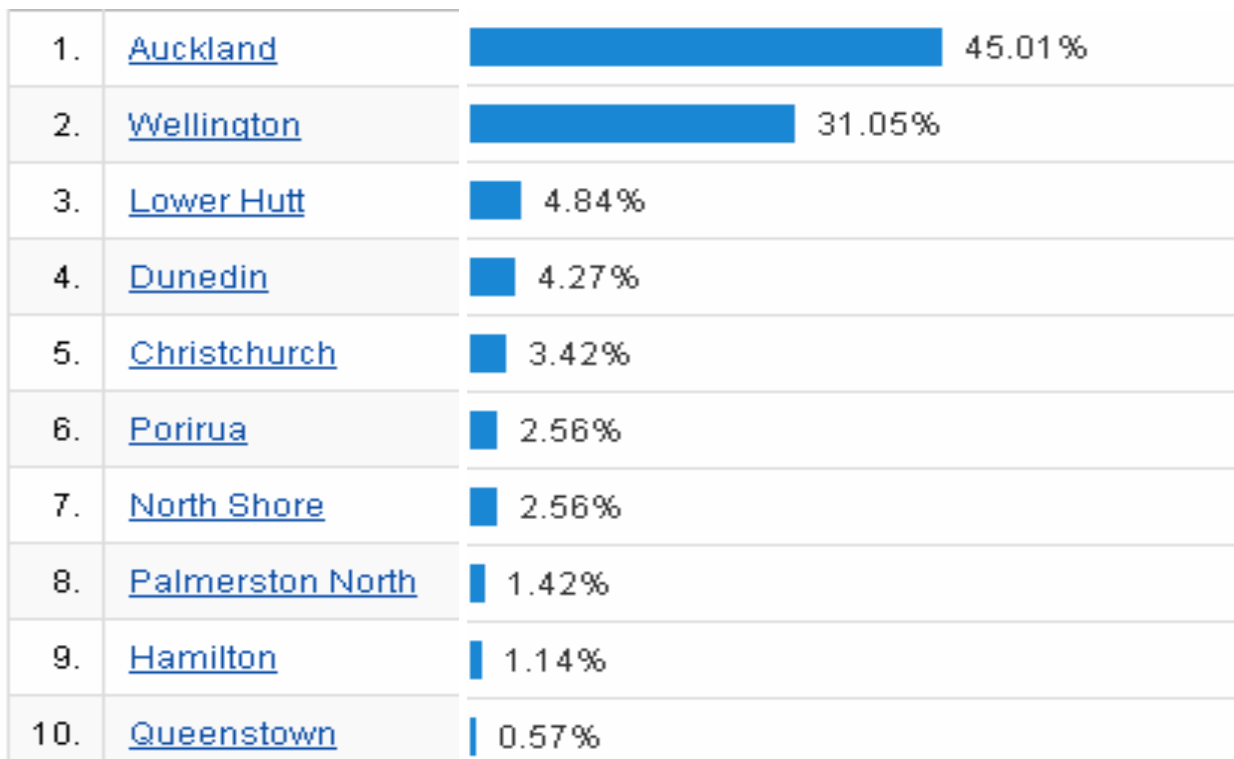

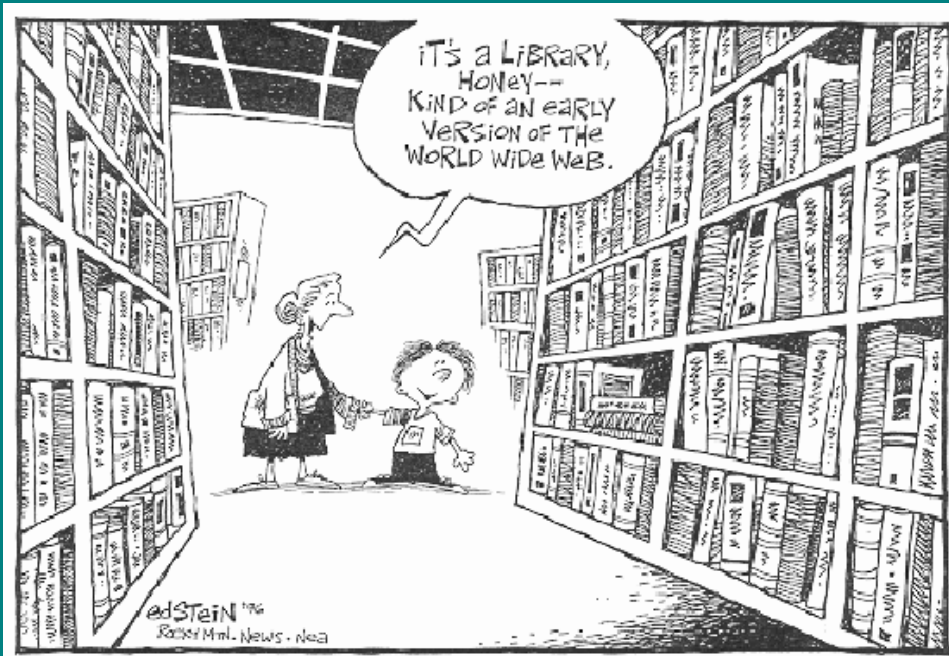

To find words together, in order type a phrase within quotes e.g. "agricultural injuries"

To find either word (or both) type OR between the words e.g. youth OR adolescents
